There is a pattern of claiming lack of financial support ; that Charity Worker is undertaking paid position; no previous experience of 'job'; applicant 'unsuitable'. All in all it appears to be a deliberate twisting and interpreting of role of Charity Worker, there has been no forewarning of the need for greater clarity. the form we fill in uses language attached to employed role 'care worker' does not allow us to tick Charity worker. Tier 5 guidelines quote that worker can undertake any 'job' asked of them. The long standing history of volunteering in our organisation ignored and we have been submitting applications with less information and no problems for years.
